## Itinerary for trip to Hillsboro:

4:00 pm - load equipment truck

## To get to Hill College:

Hill College is located just off I-35 in Hillsboro, approximately 40 minutes north of Waco. Take the **Hwy 22 exit** (Exit #368A) and turn right on Hwy 22. Go four-tenths of a mile and turn left onto the campus. Our performance will be held in the **Vara Martin Daniel Performing Arts Center** (located in the middle of campus?) on the Hill College Campus. It is about 35 miles/45 minutes from MCC.

*FROM LANNY: The exit is also known as the Hillsboro Outlet Mall Exit. Seven-Eleven and McDonalds are on the right as you turn onto HWY 22. The street you turn left onto is Lamar Drive and is just before the Church of Christ which is also on the left. The Fine Arts area of the college is up the hill past the apartments and to the right. There is a parking lot and fountain/pool in front the PAC. The PAC is actually behind the History/Museum building. It will be to your right.*
